



Beneficiaries Vs years





GROUNDBREAKING IMPACT IN MEDIRIGIRIYA:

A TALE OF TRANSFORMATION

In the rural village of Medirigiriya in the Polonnaruwa district, nestled in the northwest corner of Sri Lanka, a story unfolded, creating a ripple of hope that would profoundly alter the lives of its residents. The village had long grappled with the harsh reality of scarce clean water. Relying on distant, contaminated sources, the population faced waterborne diseases, including Chronicle Kidney Diseases (CDK), leading to immense suffering. The introduction of a program became a beacon of hope, marking a significant turning point in their lives.

The program entered this remote village like a ray of hope. A total of six Very Deep wells were constructed in the heart of Polonnaruwa, offering this community a lifeline to clean water. For Medirigiriya, the impact was both immediate and profound. Clean water translated to improved health, as the occurrences of water-borne illnesses significantly decreased. The community could now reclaim their time, as they no longer needed to embark on long, arduous journeys to collect water.



This initiative reflects our commitment to ensuring lasting access to standard Water, Sanitation and Hygiene practices. GER-SL expanded its interventions in the districts of Trincomalee, Batticaloa, Vavuniya, and Polonnaruwa in Sri Lanka. Notably, the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene team executed a distinctive project, providing latrine facilities to 150 households in the district of Batticaloa, Sri Lanka. This project is pivotal in transforming daily sanitation practices into improved ones.

Our objective extends beyond the provision of Water, Sanitation and Hygiene facilities for the present; it aims to secure their availability for generations to come, reinforcing the bonds between us and the communities we serve.

Realizing Aspirations in Kahatagasdigiliya.

In the heart of the Division of Kahatagasdigiliya in the Anuradhapura district of Sri Lanka lies the story of Kahatagastigiliya Muslim M/V, a remote village school brimming with aspirations. This is the narrative of a program that breathed life into its dreams.

Communities in Kahatagasdigiliya faced a challenging educational journey, with the school situated several miles away. The daily commute for students meant embarking on a long and arduous journey, leaving them exhausted and consuming precious time. The dream of academic excellence and reaching new heights felt distant and unattainable.

The program served as a lifeline for schools like Kahatagastigiliya Muslim M/V, acknowledging the daunting challenges they faced. The introduction of the Bicycle Distribution Initiative emerged as a pragmatic remedy, fundamentally transforming the educational landscape for this school and its 50 students in Kahatagasdigiliya. The initiative, a simple yet powerful solution, proved to be a catalyst for positive change.

The influence on the academic performance of the school was truly noteworthy. Student grades experienced a substantial rise, and their engagement in school activities increased with renewed enthusiasm. Beyond being time and energy-saving tools, the bicycles cultivated a deep sense of confidence and motivation, emboldening these students to aspire to greater dreams and reach for higher achievements.



The essence of the "Sustainable Livelihoods" program lies in our unwavering commitment to empowering individuals and communities, fostering economic self-sufficiency, and alleviating poverty. We understand that offering avenues for sustainable income generation is pivotal in breaking the cycle of dependency.

In the current year, the program manifested its dedication by delivering two canoes to individuals, presenting them with opportunities to make a living.

These canoes transcend mere modes of transportation; they become tools for economic empowerment, particularly in communities where water bodies play an integral role in daily life.



Mursalima's Ramadan Journey

In a modest village, Mursalima, a resilient mother, discovered solace and support through our Ramadan project. For a family reliant on daily wages, Ramadan had always posed challenges. The project, delivering Food Aid, emerged as a beacon of hope for Mursalima and her family.

The Food Aid not only provided nourishment but also alleviated the financial strain of preparing a meal for her children during the holy month. Ensuring that the family had enough to sustain them for at least two to three weeks of Ramadan, the Food Aid brought a profound sense of relief to Mursalima.

Beyond nourishing their bodies, the Ramadan project uplifted their spirits, transforming Ramadan into a time of joy, community, and shared blessings for Mursalima and her children. In her own words:

We live in a temporary dwelling with a makeshift roof and try to make enough money to pay for essentials, including our children's schooling and other expenditures. We are having a hard time getting the commodities we need during this month of Ramadan. GER-SL gave us food packs, which showed that humanity is still living.



AASURAH

Muharram, a part of the revered 'Ashyurul Hurum,' is one of the four sacred months of Allah (SWT). Throughout this month, believers are encouraged to intensify their good deeds, encompassing acts such as charity, voluntary prayers, and Quran recitation. Rasulullah (SAW) also prescribed a fast during this time, known as the Ashura fast.

In observance of this significant period, GER-SL extended support to 2500 individuals, enabling them to engage in the act of fasting during the Ashura days. This support was provided through the distribution of cooked meals for Iftar, aligning with the spirit of community and shared blessings during this sacred month.

AQIQAH

An Agigah traditionally occurs on the seventh day after a baby's birth, although it may also be performed at a later date. This ceremonial event entails the distribution of meat from a sacrificed animal to those in need.

In adherence to Islamic tradition, GER-SL executed the Agigah ceremony on behalf of the donors. The goat meat from the sacrifice was then distributed to the less fortunate, exemplifying the essence of 'Ageegah'—a gesture of gratitude and a means of sharing blessings with those in need.

TEN DAYS OF DHUL-HIJJAH **NOURISHMENT**

This initiative revolves around the provision of cooked meals to those in need during the sacred period of Dhul Hijjah. Acknowledging the importance of this time, characterized by compassion and generosity, the project aspires to promote fasting during Dhul-Hijjah.

Through this meaningful endeavor, we successfully delivered nourishing and wholesome meals to individuals and families. This ensured that they had sustenance during the special first days of Dhul Hijjah, aligning with the spirit of community, compassion, and shared blessings during this auspicious period.
